The REA and CNG Services have been running Biomethane Day since 2012 and it is the largest gathering in the gas-to-grid industry. With 84 plants having injected biomethane by the end of 2017, "Green Gas" is starting to make a material contribution on the UK's path to lower carbon.

The focus of Biomethane Day 2018 will be to brief the industry on policy developments relevant to biomethane (heat and transport policy) as well as new projects coming on line, innovation, technology development, R&D, green gas certification and market.

There have been important developments in relation to the use of grid injected biomethane as a transport fuel, with changes to the RTFO scheme acting to support biomethane. The new Bio-CNG trucks made by Scania (500 mile range) and Iveco and the developments by CNG Fuels and Waitrose mean that it is possible to adopt a 100% diesel free transport fleet.

Biomethane Day is a fantastic networking opportunity, where developers and operators can meet financiers, feedstock providers, waste hauliers, government officials and suppliers. This year we are expecting over 300 delegates, with exhibition stands from all of the major suppliers to the Biomethane industry. If you are considering Biomethane to Grid, this is the one industry event you cannot afford to miss.



The Biogas Group of the REA is the established voice for the UK biogas industry. Over the past nine years we have worked with our partners and stakeholders to convince successive Governments of the benefits of Biomethane injection, resulting in the introduction of the Renewable Heat Incentive in 2011.

Our subsequent work has been directed towards successfully overcoming technical and regulatory barriers, safeguarding income and ensuring that sustainability rules are fair and achievable.

We are looking forward to UK Biomethane Day, which promises to be another fantastic event.
