Featured articles include the recent launch of the UK's first biomethane to grid (BtG) project at Didcot sewage works, the BtG project at Adnams brewery, biomethane as a vehicle fuel and the innovative plans for a biomethane network linking dairy farms in Cheshire. It also includes the feasibility study in relation to plans for a Bio-SNG (Synthetic Natural Gas) project in the NE of England.

The newsletter also details CSL's other natural gas projects such as a compressed natural gas filling station in Kazakhstan and support to Sheffield City Council's introduction of CNG to improve air quality.

The UK has been behind other EU countries in relation to biomethane and CNG but we are now catching up and this market is creating jobs with two new staff appointed to the company.
