# **Our Priorities**

- Ensure the Green Gas Support Scheme (GGSS) is fit for purpose
- Maximise potential of biomethane and associated co-products
- Implement a holistic future policy framework



### **GGSS Update**

#### GGSS (Amendment) Regs 2024 (4 June)

- Provide a ~2.5-year extension to 31 March 2028
  - Aligns with Defra's *Simpler Recycling* policy
  - Allows for applicants facing supply chain delays
  - Aims to avoid a gap in future support
- Removed penalty for eligible heat pump use

#### Annual Tariff Review (30 August)

- From 1 October 2024:
  - Tier 1 tariff = 6.69 p/kWh (5.6% v April)
  - Tier 2 tariff = 4.16 p/kWh (2.5%)
  - Tier 3 tariff = 3.88 p/kWh (8.1%)
- For new applicants only

### **New Government, New Missions**

Biomethane will have a role to play in several new missions:

#### **Clean Power**

Decarbonising where electrification is not an option

#### **Circular Economy**

- Waste feedstock
- Digestate
- Biogenic  $CO_2$

#### **Industrial Strategy**

Decarbonising hard-toabate industries




### **Call for Evidence**

Feedback:

- 1. Need a clear vision setting out the role for the biomethane sector to 2050
- 2. Both small and large-scale AD have an important role to play
- 3. Addressing issues with the planning process would stimulate development
- 4. Reviewing plant standards and permitting could drive production through safe, high-quality plants
- 5. Valorising digestate is key to unlocking its potential as a fertiliser
- 6. Recognition of biomethane under the UK ETS could enhance its commercial viability
- 7. A market-based mechanism could move the sector to being more self-sustaining
- 8. A production target could help drive up production volumes


